# What is College Signing Day?

College Signing Day is an opportunity to celebrate students committing to pursue their education past high school,

whether to obtain a two-year degree, a four-year degree, a certificate or industryrecognized credential, as well as students entering the military. Traditionally we celebrate on May 1<sup>st</sup> to coincide with the deadline many colleges and universities set for students to commit to attend.
